

II. New Testament Verbs for Follow-Up/Discipleship/Fellowship:

Chart of Verbs and Verbal Nouns in Follow-Up, Discipleship, or Local Church Contexts by Category

Explanation: The first number in the chart represents the assigned number in the following notes; the second number corresponds to the number of evangelistic New Testament uses of the word in these notes (a zero indicates an Old Testament Septuagint use).

Comparative: This chart was developed to provide a comparison of verbs in evangelism contexts with verbs in follow-up and discipleship contexts

Disclaimer: This chart is not exhaustive and categories are general in nature; because cognate verbs and nouns are kept together and due to differing contexts, there may be some overlap or duplication in categories. There ought not be repeated use of the same verb.
